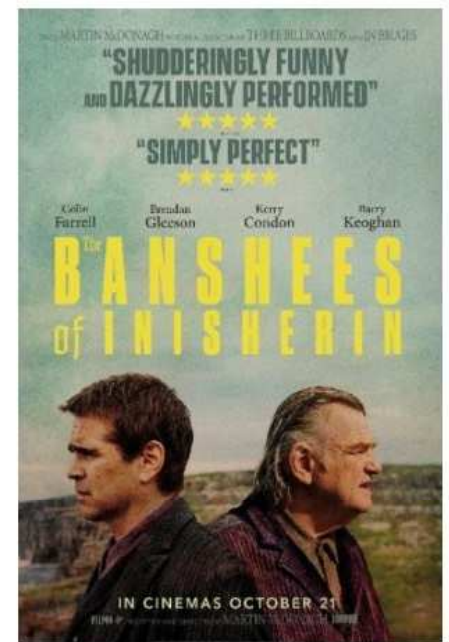


what about the movie?

The Banshees of Inisherin is a 2022 Irish dramatic movie directed by Martin McDonagh. The story is set in the 20s on a fictional Irish island during the civil war. It talks about the breakup between two bestfriends : Padraic and Colm, who one day decides that he no longer wants to be friend with Padraic, in order to focus on his own peace, and music. The plot tells how Pádraic, confused and hurt tries to understand this decision.

The atmosphere of the film was scary and melancholic . This isolated island shows the loneliness of the characters. There's a growing tension reflecting the breakup of this friendship and the backdrop of a civil war which reinforces this heavy atmosphere.

What we will remember is that this movie highlights the dangers of isolation and the impact of a lack of communication on people which can be hurtful. It represents the importance of human connections.
